

## Business Intelligence Analyst

### Job Summary

The Business Intelligence Analyst will be a key member of the Technology Group, reporting to the Business Intelligence Manager. He or she will be responsible for interpreting data, analyzing results, developing and deploying reporting to Goodnight's business units. This is an exempt level position.

### Responsibilities

- Discovering, scrubbing and organizing data from disconnected systems
- Performing analysis on large data sets and producing quantitative visualizations
- Data mining legacy systems to integrate into production databases
- Collaborating with Automation, Finance, Accounting, and IT Operations to gather and prioritize their business requirements
- Developing and automating reporting / dashboards for Goodnight's business units, including the Executive Team
- Building custom connectors to integrate standalone systems using API, SQL queries, and other methods
- Providing technical support for existing reports, dashboards and other tools
- Assisting with management and deployment of the company's purchase order system
- Ad hoc projects as requested

### Education, Experience and Technical Skills Required:

- Bachelor's degree in Finance, Computer Science, or related field is required
- Two to four years of related and relevant experience is needed for this role
- Experience with big data technologies and data analytics is required
- Demonstrated expertise in the related IT technical domains including Splunk and SQL Server
- Project management experience; including: delivering implementation projects for new solutions in complex environments, with many stakeholders (technical disciplines, IT, oil and gas customers, Software Developers, automation and instrumentation teams)
- Knowledge of the following applications is required: Excel and SQL
- Knowledge of Splunk, Qlik and Scripting Tools is strongly preferred

The candidate should be highly skilled in the following areas: problem solving, organization and prioritization, attention to detail, active listening, verbal and written communication. This position requires a self-starter/self-learner that demonstrates clear accountability and can adapt easily whether working independently or with a team. The candidate must have a strong sense of urgency and sound judgment. Must possess a strong work ethic, and ability to meet deadlines. This candidate must be able to work independently and make sound decisions. Ability to plan out, manage, document and delegate multiple concurrent projects.

### Working Environment/Physical Requirements:

Remains stationary at least 75% of the time. This position constantly operates computers, printers and other office productivity machines (e.g., fax machine, copier, etc.) Occasionally required to move documents or files weighing up to 10 lbs. This position requires constant verbal and written communication and exchange of information with other staff. This position must be able to inspect and

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observe information on a computer screen at least 80% of the time. The position will have a travel component of 0-10%.
