

Contract Landman

Job Summary

This contract position will provide support for ROW acquisition efforts in West Texas/Permian Basin region. The contract Landman will represent Goodnight Midstream during meetings with landowners, and will interface with lease brokers to coordinate ROW acquisition.

Responsibilities

- Negotiate surface use agreements
- Provide support for operations staff on all land related issues

Education and Experience:

Ideal candidate will possess a minimum of 2 years of experience with surface in the Permian. High school diploma, general education degree (GED), or equivalent required. Associates degree or higher preferred. AAPL membership preferred. Flexibility regarding day travel, as well as the ability to work remotely is required. Must be highly proficient with Microsoft Office programs. Preferably a member of the AAPL and local to West Texas.

Must be self-sufficient, detail oriented and possess the ability to manage information, time and prioritize tasks to maximum efficiency. Work well under pressure, meeting deadlines consistently. Effective written and verbal communication skills are a must.

Working Environment/Physical Requirements:

Remains stationary at least 75% of the time; Moves about the office 25% of the time. This position constantly operates computers, printers and other office productivity machines (e.g., fax machine, copier, etc.) Occasionally required to move or lift documents/files weighing up to 10 lbs. This position requires constant verbal and written communication and exchange of information with clients, vendors and other staff. This position must be able to inspect and observe information on a computer screen at least 80% of the time.
