### Responsibilities

- Serves as the finance team liaison to the operations team.
- Create a monthly reporting database to be sent to field supervisors showing Operating Expenses by area of responsibility and individual assets.
- Create quarterly report for Supervisors showing operating expense data by area of responsibility and by individual assets, and include volumes and cost per unit basis, key changes in cost drivers presented in graphical form, overtime reports and unusual trends.
- Assist Finance and Accounting in developing AFEs and properly tracking and analyzing costs.
- Track AFE expenditures with regular progress reporting.
- Provide support as needed to Drilling Mgr, Land, EHS and Geology.
