

## **I&E Construction Manager**

**Job Summary:** This exempt-level position will report directly to Engineering. This position will work closely with IT, SCADA Developers, Operations and the Capital Projects teams.

### **Responsibilities**

- Work closely with the Project Team in managing the following trades and contractors, on assigned projects:
  - Electrical contractors.
  - Instrumentation and Controls Contractors.
  - Skid manufacturers and PLC programmers.
- Provide hands-on assistance and guidance in SWD and RTU start-ups.
- Develop load sheets and secure utility power in a timely manner.
- Participate in temporary equipment selection such as rental gensets, temporary pumps, fuel supplies, etc if early startup of facilities is required
- Manage installation of field cameras and monitoring systems.
- Maintain project schedules, and ensure tasks are completed in a timely fashion.
- Develop drawings for turnkey bidding in order to construct an I&E system that adheres to company standards.
- Oversee the I&E portion of assigned capital projects and track AFE's.
- Adhere to and promote company's safety policies.
- Verify I&E contractors and ensure they are staying in scope.
- Manage multiple construction project assignments simultaneously and meet deadlines.
- Ensure all safety, environmental and Company policies/procedures are communicated and enforced.
- Manage and ensure work crews follow all customer, safety and environmental requirements.
- Build and maintain positive working relationships with customers, subcontractors and vendors, at all times.
- Participate in developing company standards that start with the input device and end with the SCADA development package.
- Other tasks and projects may be assigned, as needed.

### **Education and Experience:**

Two-year degree or completion of trade school strongly preferred; Minimum of 5 years of project management experience is required, or equivalent combination of education and experience will be considered. Previous industrial field electrician experience and industrial automation experience required. Prior experience managing contractors and vendors is needed for this role.

**Other Job Requirements:** Must have the ability and willingness to spend long hours in the field during critical activities. MS Office proficiency, project management software, and high level of comfort with computers and various productivity technology.

The candidate should be highly skilled in the following areas: project management, problem solving, task prioritization, active listening, verbal and written communications. This position requires a self-starter/self-learner that demonstrates clear accountability and can adapt easily whether working independently or with a team. The candidate must have a strong sense of urgency and sound judgment. Must possess a strong work ethic, ability to manage multiple projects and staff simultaneously and meet deadlines. This candidate must be able to work independently and make sound decisions.

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### Working Environment/Physical Requirements:

Must be able to regularly perform physical tasks such as entering a confined space, climbing stairs and ladders, and walking long distances. Outdoor work in all weather conditions. Must be able to frequently climb ladders, crawl, crouch and kneel occasionally. Frequent lifting required up to 25 lbs, with average occasional lifting of up to 50 lbs. Walking/pushing/pulling are also frequently required. Operates a vehicle at least 70% of the time. Must be willing to work outside of normal business hours and have a flexible schedule. Candidate must possess valid driver's license and clean driving record. Work in adverse driving and inclement weather conditions, and frequent work with and around high-pressure water pipelines, possibly toxic chemicals and flammable products, moving and/or hot and cold equipment, and high noise levels.
